ORDER OF NOLLE PROSEQUI



THIS INFORMATION IS CONFIDENTIAL AND IS FOR THE USE OF AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL ONLY

ON 1/9/18 I, DEPUTY JOHNSTON, OBSERVED A VEHICLE RUN THE STOP SIGN AT THE INTERSECTION OF FISK/ SHAGRAO RD.

I FOLLOWED DOWN FISK RD AND OBSERVED THE VEHICLE TO TURN RIGHT ON WHITTAKER SPRINGS RD. WHEN I TURNED ON TO WHITTAKER SPRINGS RD I OBSERVED THE VEHICLE TO PULL INTO A DRIVEWAY AND BACK OUT BEFORE I COULD PULL IT OVER. THE VEHICLE SAW ME AND CONTINUED TOWARDS FISK RD.

I OBSERVED THE VEHICLE TO SPEED AWAY UP FISK RD. I QUICKLY TURNED AROUND AND CONTINUED NORTH UP FISK RD. I ENCOUNTERED THE VEHICLE WRECKED OUT AT FISK RD/ FISK PARK DR. I IMMEDIATELY IDENTIFIED THE VEHICLE AS THE ONE THAT RAN THE STOP SIGN TRAVELING AT HIGH RATES OF SPEED. I ALSO IMMEDIATELY IDENTIFIED THE DRIVER TO BE CASEY EMERTON.

UPON MAKING CONTACT WITH MS. EMERTON I COULD SMELL A STRONG ODOR OF ALCOHOL ABOUT HER BREATHE AND PERSON. MS. EMERTON ALSO HAD RED WATERY EYES. MS. EMERTON WAS BLEEDING AND I ADVISED DISPATCH TO HAVE EMS RESPOND TO MY LOCATION.

MS. EMERTON WAS TRANSPORTED TO THE HOSPITAL BY EMS.

I RESPONDED TO THE SHERIFF'S DEPT TO OBTAIN A SEARCH WARRANT FOR BLOOD.

WHEN I RESPONDED TO THE HOSPITAL TO OBTAIN THE BLOOD DRAW MS. EMERTON BECAME VERY UNCOOPERATIVE AND IRATE. MS. EMERTON REFUSED MEDICAL TREATMENT AT THE HOSPITAL.

ONCE I GAVE AND READ THE SEARCH WARRANT TO HER SHE STARTED TO BECOME IRATE AGAIN WITH THE MEDICAL STAFF. AFTER TALKING TO HER AND GIVING THE SEARCH WARRANT TO HER AGAIN SHE ALLOWED THE MEDICAL STAFF TO DRAW BLOOD.

AFTER THE BLOOD DRAW SHE REFUSED MEDICAL TREATMENT NOT COOPERATING WITH THE MEDICAL STAFF AND REFUSING ANY TEST AGAINST HER BETTER JUDGMENT THE HOSPITAL GAVE HER RELEASE PAPERS AND SHE WAS TRANSPORTED TO THE JAIL.

MS. EMERTON WAS SERVED WITH A WARRANT FOR DUI WITH \$1000 BOND AND COURT ON 2/5/18.


On May 9, 2018, I was approached by Deputy Kamron Johnston during Putnam County General Sessions Court. Deputy Johnston told me he had a DUI case coming up soon and we needed to "just dismiss it." Deputy Johnston told me we needed to "just leave it at that." At that time, I was not in a position to have a lengthy conversation on the matter, so I told Deputy Johnston I would look at the case when it came up. I cannot recall if Deputy Johnston told me who the defendant was at that time. Our conversation was brief, as Deputy Johnston was about to testify in a preliminary hearing, and I had cases to attend to.

Shortly thereafter, Attorney Shawn Fry approached me and began to explain that Deputy Johnston may have sent inappropriate text messages to his client, Casey Emerton. Mr. Fry alluded that the substance of those messages may have referenced sexual favors in exchange for assistance with her case. Mr. Fry did not go into detail about what the messages said, proposed, or possibly promised exactly. I told Mr. Fry I would look into the case when it came up.

My current understanding is that Deputy Johnston may have sent messages to Ms. Emerton requesting sexual acts in exchange for help with, and possibly a dismissal of, her DUI case. I made no promises or suggestions to Deputy Johnston, Mr. Fry, or Ms. Emerton. I told both Mr. Fry and Deputy Johnston I would look at the case when it came up. I have not been provided with, or observed, any of the above referenced text messages.

Just getting back to you concerning my meeting today with Ms. Emerton. Ms. Emerton informs me that she is now pregnant. Currently she is not married but is engaged. Her fiancé, although aware of his DUI case, is not aware of her exchanging Facebook messages and texts with Deputy Johnston. She would like to keep it that way. She is very concerned about what might happen if he finds out about these messages. At this time she wants to think about what she is going to do and does not want me to share these texts with your office. She would like to think about it over the weekend.

I have now had a better opportunity to look at her case and we have recently dismissed cases a lot stronger than hers. It is my understanding that there is no video in this case, no field sobriety tests and the only real evidence against her is the blood test which is currently not admissible. I've also heard through the rumor mill that Deputy Johnston is no longer employed with the sheriff's department? If he is no longer employed, then you would not need these messages? That is why she is so hesitant for me to show them to anyone. She does not want anyone to find out about them especially her fiancé. I hope you'll have an opportunity to agree to dismiss her case and did not prosecute officer Johnston for anything. Perhaps you can check it to confirm that he has no longer employed with the sheriff's department? Her case is not set until Wednesday, July 11 so she has plenty of time to change her mind and you have an opportunity also to hopefully dismiss her case. I'm sure if you agreed to that she would have no problem showing you these messages.

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

Mr. Fry:

It is my understanding that on May 9, 2018 you approached Asst. DA Jamie Hargis in court and explained to him that you had in your possession copies of text messages that had been sent between your client, Ms. Casey Emerton and a local law enforcement officer that revealed that offers of sexual favors were suggested in exchange for leniency on her pending criminal charges.

You will remember that you and I spoke on the phone. You confirmed with me that you do have copies of such messages. We arranged to meet up today, May 25, 2018 after you met with your client this morning so that you could provide me copies of those messages. In response to a text message to you, you emailed me letting me know that "she" does not want you to give me the messages.

I also read your evaluation of the DUI. You are incorrect on several things. There is incriminating video related to the case, etc. I am also aware that you have showed those messages to Major Greg Whitaker with the PCSO and that facilitated the administrative leave of the officer.

Frankly, you are in possession of the messages and I am now formally requesting that you preserve and not destroy those messages and that you

provide them to me as they are direct evidence of a potential criminal offense. Casey Emerlon does not have discretion as to whether to disclose them.

Mr. Fry:

I am making one more attempt to request that you deliver the text messages that you possess related to communication between Kamron Johnson and Casey Emerton. You have made an allegation that an officer has potentially committed a felony. As I stated in our telephone conversation, if such allegation is true and you provide copies of those confirming messages, I am likely going to be unable to prosecute your client's DUI. Without having the benefit of those copies, I am not inclined to dismiss the DUI. I have issued a subpoena for Kamron Johnston to testify at the preliminary hearing. You are on notice of potential dishonesty (by your own claim) on his part. You will be in a position to be forced to impeach him at the hearing. You may also be placing yourself in a position as a potential witness.

You have indicated that Ms. Emerton has a desire to not make the existence of these messages known. The manner in which you are addressing this issue is not in any way going to keep the fact of the messages from becoming known. In fact, it will facilitate their disclosure having the opposite result. I respectfully ask, once again, that you provide copies of the messages. Should you continue to decline my request, I will have to consider judicial process to obtain them. I ask that you please do not make that necessary.
