And the FFL received a warning letter in 2011. The current inspection is a recall inspection in which the FFL's quantity of errors for A&D violations increased (9 to 19) representing an error rate of 2.3% to 3.0%. additional violation, not previously cited, indicate a WC per the adverse action policy – the sale of a handgun to an out of state resident. The FFL has processes in place and the ability to comply with the relevant laws and regulations but has been unable to prevent


